

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE OF CBA SUBSCRIPTION SERVICES

1 Acceptance of Terms: Ove Arup & Partners Ltd ('Arup') provides Construction and Building Abstracts (CBA) Subscription Service (the 'Service') to its subscribers ('you') subject to the following Terms and Conditions. These Terms and Conditions may be updated by Arup ('we') from time to time and we will endeavour to provide reasonable notice to you of any changes. 2: The Service is the copyright of Arup. All data and software on the CBA Website, plus any materials supplied separately under this agreement, are copyrighted and/or are the property of Arup.

Arup's liability shall otherwise be limited to the subscription sum.

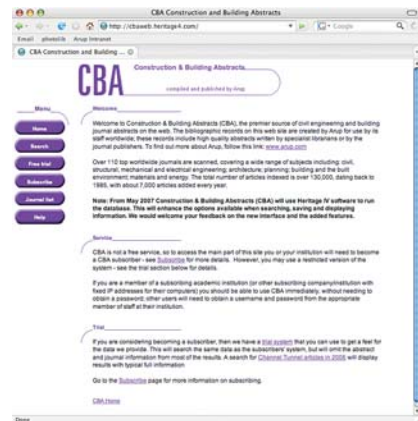

Construction and Building Abstracts (CBA) is created and published by Arup. It is a database giving bibliographic details of over 135 000 abstracts, with some 7000 new abstracts added every year from over 100 construction-related journals from around the world. All records from the last ten years, and the majority of earlier records, contain high quality abstracts written by the journal publisher or Arup's own specialist librarians. Newer records also include weblinks to facilitate access to full-text articles.



Wide scope and coverage

- The scope includes engineering, building technology and architecture.
- The contents cover the entire construction process: briefing, design, construction, maintenance, rehabilitation and demolition.
- Marketing, quality assurance, legislation and health and safety are also included when they relate to the construction industry.
- It is possible to conduct specific searches for building types, buildings by name, individual engineers and architects, construction companies or organisations, as well as general topics.
